    - Move boulders so they are not obstructing the signage.
    - Tree maintenance. Need to scale back the trees and do some heavy pruning. May need to remove 1 tree. At most 2 but unlikely.
    - Turf is in bad shape. Working to fix the turf areas.
- Some neighbors are backwashing on grass. Sent letters
- Sent letter about trees over wall in common area. If they don't comply then we will have to have our trimmers do it.
